When a citizen calls to make a police report and it is not a situation that is going on at this time, one of our officers will be calling you back on the phone to talk with you. The officer will be getting all of the information needed to complete the report for you. If the officer has any follow up questions they will again contact you via the phone.

We also have an email setup for anyone to make a report if needed. The type of reports that can be done via email are listed below. Again, when it is received, an officer will get in touch via telephone and go over the email to make sure they have all of the pertinent information to complete the report for you.
